Bonded debt refinanced at average of 2.2%. Half of million dollar discretionary allocated to future PERS and 25% to Skyline sidewalk by High School. Package neighborhood amenities / facilities / improvements for city wide bond? Balance needs with budget funds.

Ethan Krow - Better Oregon Coalition - Parents, teachers and small businesses on state of the state economy, corporate tax structure and state measures. Raising corporate tax rates on big out of state corporations. Resources so that no child slips through the cracks.
