**Monthly Meeting Minutes**

President Bryck called the meeting to order and introduced Captain Dave Haley with TVFR. Capt. Haley came to advocate for the passage of the fire levy on the ballot for the November election. Mary Hill asked if a fire station at the top of the hill will ever happen. Capt. Haley indicated not likely. Response times to the top of the hill are limited due to the terrain, but available land for a fire station is also limited.

Carolyn Miller, the new Cedar Oak principal came to introduce herself.

Gerry St. Pierre – restoration coordinator for Willamette Riverkeeper; discussed plans for removing invasive species on Cedar Oak Island, specifically Ivy & Blackberry. Offered canoe trips during the summer for neighborhood residents.

Candidates for public office. Mayoral candidate Mike Kapigian and Council candidates Kathy Conroy, Ron Whitehead as well as a representative for John Kovash were each given five minutes to make presentations.

President Bryck discussed a Council measure to formalize NA names and boundaries, and suggested the Council clarify by-laws.

The Council is scheduled to formally discuss the Transportation System Plan (TSP) on Nov. 5<sup>th</sup>.

Shady Hollow zoning change – unanimously recommended by the Planning Commission and approved by the City Council with 4 conditions to mitigate effects on the neighborhood is waiting for a formal development plan.

No previous minutes or treasurer's report were presented.
