**APPROVED MEETING MINUTES**

March 5, 2020

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**1. Call to Order**

In view of the health concerns regarding the coronavirus, the March meeting was held on Zoom. Abby Farber called the meeting to order at 7.05 pm.

**2. Review & Approve Agenda**

The agenda was reviewed and unanimously approved.

**3. Review & Approve last month's minutes**

The minutes of the February 6<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved

**4. Review & Approve Treasurer's Report and/or Bank Statement**

There were no transactions since the last meeting when the N.A. has a balance of \$8,781.20 in its bank account with Pacific West. \$1,000 of the funds have been set aside for a bench at Sahallie Illahee park.

**5. Unfinished Business**

- a. Neighborhood Signs – Abby displayed the sign that had been proposed by John Walker. The sign features in the upper left an etching of Mount Hood. On the right side, there are 3 lines of wording. The first line (in smaller font) are the words City of West Linn. The second reads (in larger font) – Rosemont Summit. The final reads – Neighborhood, in the same font size as Rosemont Summit. The design was unanimously approved. John will contact the city to get 2 signs placed in location previously approved by the N.A.
- b. Ibach Park - David Kleinke delivered a PowerPoint presentation that illustrated the work that has been done at the park. Among the volunteers who helped were volunteers from the LDS church. Photos showed the status of the work in January, February and March. Thanks to a donation by Native Plantscapes NW, 1,000 native plants were planted with a view to planting for diversity. David indicated that in April the city will deliver wood chips to provide ground coverage and retain moisture on the cleared surface.
- c. RSNA Goals for 2020. This topic was deferred until the April meeting.

- d. Bolton N.A. request. Discussion of the request by the Bolton N.A. concerning a resolution about keeping Burnside Park a forever wilderness location was postponed until April. Abby will contact Bolton N.A. to invite a representative of that N.A. to attend the April meeting to give (1) background on Burnside Park, (2) the reason for concern about development at Burnside Park and (3) whether acceptable improvements would include restrooms, water fountain and benches.
- e. Sahallie Illahee Playground – Abby will contact the West Linn Parks and Recreation Department concerning the work schedule for the playground.

## **6. New Business**

Abby gave a brief overview of the work done by the Concerned Citizens of West Linn on the recent controversy involving the West Linn Police Department. More information can be found on the group's Facebook page. Abby will invite a representative of the organization to the April N.A. meeting so that the representative can update the members of the N.A.
