May 12, 2022

1. Call to Order

Abby Farber called the Zoom meeting to order at 7.02 pm.

2. Review & Approve minutes of April meeting.

The minutes of the April meeting will be reviewed in the July meeting.

3. Treasurer's Report

The N.A. had a balance of \$3.632.37 at the end of March.

4. Installing Cross Signs on Rosemont Road

Cross flags are now located on four intersections along Santa Anita. The N.A. confirmed its decision that cross flags should be placed on Rosemont Road at the crosswalk closest to the entrance to Oppenlander fields

5. Potential Topics for Future Meetings

- In view of the increasing crime in Portland, it might be good to ask WL Chief of Police, Peter Mahuna, to Update the N.A. on crime in WL.
- Perhaps several N.A. could hold a joint meeting on Emergency Management.
 Presenters could include Brenna Cruz, WL Emergency Manager Coordinator, The Red Cross, TVFR, etc.

6. Get to Know Your Neighbor

The members of the N.A. expressed interest in holding a Get to Know Your Neighbor event a Sahallie Illahee Park on Sunday, July 24th from 2 pm to 5 pm. In addition to residents of N.A., the N.A. could invite volunteers who have given time to help improve the park. The mayor, members of the city council, and members of the WL Parks and Recreation Department could be invited.

The N.A. will explore whether a couple of the food carts that participate in the Willamette Street Market or who will be based at the Food Cart location on Willamette Main Steer at the former site of Russ Auto Care, at the corner of Willamette Falls Drive and Dollar Street would be willing to provide food and beverage for sale.

The possibility of contests for the kids was also discussed.

7. Sahallie Illahee Park / Recycling

David Kleinke gave his monthly update on the park. Twenty-seven volunteers participated in the April 10th cleanup of the park. The work was in the Barlow Creek area and focused on the removal of blackberry and ivy.

The next Solve Event will be May 15th at Fields Bridge Park.

The next Solve Event at Sahallie Illahee Park will be June 12th from 9 am to 12 noon. The work will focus on nipplewort, herb Robert, wall lettuce, and hairy butter cress.

Bill & Susan Tarvin discuss the Earth Day Solve event at Wilderness Park. Over seventy volunteers participated in the event. The work focused on the removal of ivy, chips were laid on the trails, and portions of the trail were laid with gravel. As a result of the effort, six bins of debris were removed from the park.

Bill reported that a governmental agency was spraying the park to remove mustard garlic. The N.A. agreed that spraying was not necessary at Sahallie Illahee Park since invasive weeds were being removed by volunteers. The N.A. resolved that Abby would write a letter to the respective authorities indicating that the N.A. did not want spraying to be conducted at the park.

David updated the N.A. on the sustainability event to be held on Saturday, April 14th. David also informed members of the N.A. that the West Linn Adult Community Center participates in helping to recycle hard to recycle items.
