

Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting

August 22, 2015

7:00 PM

Minutes

The Special Meeting was called to order at 5:02 pm by SONA President, Ed Schwarz.

In attendance were 23 members of SONA, 6 guests, and Mr. Mike Robinson (attorney) for ConAm.

New Business:

1. A motion was made and seconded to discuss a resolution concerning the ConAm application, DR-15-11. President Schwarz presented a summary slide show which described aspects of the application, presented concerns voiced by members at previous SONA meetings, and discussed the upcoming Planning Commission hearing on this matter. Mr. Robinson was asked to clarify a few points from the presentation. Members asked questions during and after the presentation. Concerns raised by members included the eventual disposition of the 1.3 acres being retained by the property owner, Mr. Parker, and whether development of this land would add additional traffic to the Tannler and Blankenship and 10th Street / I-205 interchange. A question was asked of Mr. Robinson to clarify the number of inside parking spaces that are planned. After discussion had concluded President Schwarz presented a draft resolution for members' consideration. The resolution was projected and read aloud to the members. A motion was made and seconded to pass the resolution. After an additional opportunity for discussion, a vote was called for. The vote was 22 yes, 0 no, and 1 abstain. The motion passed. President Schwarz announced that he would present the motion to the Planning Commission at the upcoming hearing.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:52 pm.
