It is currently being planned after the Parks Department received input from West Linn children at a design event at Willamette Primary a few months ago. The proposed design concept will be presented at the August SONA meeting by Parks Director, Ken Worcester.
- 3. The Ice Cream Social was discussed and all are invited to attend.

New Business:

- 1. The Old Time Fair was discussed and people were invited to participate.
- 2. Since a few people in attendance are new to SONA meetings, a few general questions were asked and answered. A map of the fire clearance that has been mowed between the White Oak Savanna and the adjacent homes was passed around.
