

Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting

December 6th, 2016 at 7:00 PM

Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by SONA Secretary, Roberta Schwarz

In attendance were 13 people total. They included 11 members of SONA, a guest from Willamette NA and the speaker who is a Master Recycler from Clackamas County.

Meeting minutes from the November meeting were approved with a unanimous vote.

SONA Treasurer, Patrick McGuire, reported via email that the current SONA balance is \$2,672.80.

Old Business:

1. An update was given by Roberta Schwarz on the White Oak Savanna's fundraisers planned for December and January. They include a Burgerville fundraiser December 14th and a McMenamins 50% night on January 23rd. The fundraising for the lower six acres of the White Oak Savanna will be successfully completed by December/January. The Holiday Craft Fair in November was discussed as was the impressive total of \$3,000 earned at that event.
2. There was a discussion on planning a 2017 NA Potluck for the summer. Further planning will be done at the next SONA meeting.
3. The SONA list of 2016 Accomplishments and 2017 Goals was discussed and two items were added as goals and two as accomplishments. It will be given to the City as per the staff request.

New Business:

1. Terence Shumaker, a Master Recycler from Clackamas County, made an excellent presentation on what can be recycled in our bin and what can be taken and where for further recycling options. He compiled a list which he is going to add to after the conversation tonight. The list will then be sent out to all who attended the meeting tonight and to the entire SONA list. The discussion included several minutes of Q & A and everyone in attendance seemed to learn a great deal.
