## Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting February 5, 2013 7:00 PM

## **Minutes**

President Ed Schwarz called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM. In attendance were 7 members of the Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association (SONA).

Minutes from the December 4, 2012 SONA Meeting were approved 7-0.

## **Old business:**

- A member provided updates on the proposed application for 5 homes on Bland Circle at Falcon Drive. The application is scheduled to be heard by the Planning Commission on March 20, 2013. An update was also provided on the Tannler West application. There has been no activity with the city on this application.
- 2 A member provided an update on the Metro grant proposal to acquire the last 5.65 acres of the White Oak Savanna park. The grant has been submitted and a Metro tour of the park has been scheduled for March 2013.
- 3 A member provided an update on the Lake Oswego Tigard Water Treatment Plant proposal. The appeal of the Planning Commission decision is before the City Council. A decision on the appeal is expected at the next City Council meeting.
- 4 The Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association membership list was discussed. Recently, the NA reached out to its members through email and postal mail to make sure that members on the list still reside within SONA. Based on the returns from that effort, some names will be removed from the membership list as those parties no longer reside within SONA.

## **New business:**

- A member provided an update on the White Oak Savanna park. The second annual Walk/Run fundraiser for the White Oak Savanna will be held on April 14, 2003 at 9 AM at the track at Rosemont Ridge Middle School. It is hoped that 100 participants will take part. All proceeds will go towards continuing acquisition and restoration of the park. The Run/Walk is co-sponsored by the City of West Linn and Neighbors for a Livable West Linn.
- 2 A member reported that an Earth Day SOLVE project will be held at the White Oak Savanna park on April 20, 2013.
- 3 Patrick Maguire provided a summary of the Neighborhood Associations Presidents meeting that he attended on January 31, 2013.
- 4 Ed Schwarz provided a summary of the proposed changes to the Community Development Code currently being undertaken by the city.

Patrick Maguire provided the Treasurer's report.

Members discussed having a Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association get together at Douglas Park this summer. It was decided to discuss the logistics of this at the next Neighborhood Association meeting in March.
