Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting November 6, 2012 7:00 PM

Minutes

President Schwarz called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. In attendance were 10 members of the Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association (SONA).

Old Business:

- 1. Minutes from the September 4th and October 2nd meetings were approved.
- 2. Report on the Savanna Oak trail: Roberta Schwarz provided an update.
 - a. Over 100 people attended the official opening ceremony of the Savanna Oaks Trail, with food supplied and paid for by donations and Albertsons.
 - b. New aluminum trailhead signs have been purchased for \$133 instead of the \$1,200 that had been allocated for wooden ones.
 - c. NLWL Fundraisers planned for Craft Fair, another concert, and a Run/Walk event to raise the remaining \$900 needed for next summer's re-gravelling of the SO Trail.

New Business:

- 1. There was a presentation by 3J Consulting for the JT Smith Companies that is trying to develop a 5 home subdivision at 23113 Bland Circle.
 - a. There will not be a public street; the homes will be situation in a multiple flag lot arrangement with a small 16' wide driveway with a 90 degree corner for access to the two rear homes
 - i. Sprinkler systems will be needed to satisfy TVFR access concerns
 - ii. Questionable arrangements and costs for trash and recycling pickup
 - iii. A problem with field mice migrating from the construction site was mentioned and the developer asked the homeowners to talk to the site foreman.
- 2. There was no response to a request by the city to furnish the E-mail addresses of SONA members. The matter was dropped.

- 3. A request by the city to furnish the goals and plans of SONA will be addressed at the next meeting in December.
- 4. The Neighborhood Association bank balance was reported by Patrick McGuire, Treasurer.
