WHEREAS the City of West Linn will lose its United States Post Office (U.S.P.S.) at the end of February of this year due to the non-renewal of the lease at its current location; and

WHEREAS the City conducted a survey in October of 2020 and

DACCED AND ADDDOMED THIS

WHEREAS 74% of the 600 participants responded that having a physical Post Office in West Linn is very important to them and

WHEREAS the members of Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association discussed the need for West Linn to retain a U.S.P.S. in the City of West Linn;

NOW, THEREFORE, SAVANNA OAKS NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City of West Linn and its elected officials work together to find a suitable location for the U.S.P.S. building in West Linn and engage the help of our Federal Congressmen and Senators in ensuring that West Linn retains a United States Post Office for the good of all its citizens.
