

Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting
May 6th 2014

Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by Ken Pryor in the absence of SONA President, Ed Schwarz.

In attendance were 12 members of SONA.

Meeting minutes from the April 1st meeting were approved with a unanimous vote.

The Treasurer reported that the current SONA bank balance is \$1,636.65. The cost for the additions to the Neighborhood Association signs has now been deducted.

Old Business:

1. An update on the progress of Savanna Oaks fundraising is pending the results of the Sunday event at California Pizza Kitchen.
2. The sub-committee of members tasked with reviewing the “Regulatory Streaming” project reported back to the group. A resolution regarding Part 1 of this project was discussed and approved with a vote of yes from eleven out of the twelve attendees and one abstention. This member abstained as he is currently not a homeowner in West Linn and so felt that he had not followed the issue closely enough to vote.
3. An update on the most recent Land Use Pre-Application for 2900 Haskins Road was provided. Icon is now the developer for this project. The section to be designated as ‘open space’ will likely be annexed to Douglas Park.

New Business:

1. Cyndy Smith-English gave a presentation regarding the Clackamas Repertory Theatre.
2. Information on the proposed changes to the policies and procedures of the City of West Linn Planning Commission was presented and members were encouraged to attend the May 7th meeting where they are to be discussed.
3. The potential amalgamation of the Hidden Springs Neighborhood Association (HSNA) and the Rosemont Summit Neighborhood Association (RSNA) was noted and will be discussed at a later date.
4. Members were reminded that Take Care of West Linn Day is scheduled for the 17th May this year.
