

Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting

Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM by SONA President Ed Schwarz.

In attendance were 9 members of SONA and 2 guests.

Meeting minutes from the August 5, 2014 meeting were approved with a unanimous vote and no abstentions.

Treasurer Patrick McGuire gave the financial report. The current SONA bank balance stands at \$2,176.33.

Old Business:

1. An update on the White Oak Savanna was given. Forty foreign students from Japan, Korea, and Taiwan worked along with almost 30 community members to restore the Savanna. A photo of the group was passed around the meeting.
2. An update on the ConAm application was given by Ed Schwarz. The application is complete and the city has 120 days, ending December 19, 2014, to review.
3. The SONA officer election was held. All existing SONA officers were running unopposed. All existing officers were re-elected by unanimous vote. Officers for the upcoming year are: Ed Schwarz, President; Ken Pryor, Vice President; Brenda Perry, Secretary; Patrick McGuire, Treasurer.

New Business:

1. Information on three, free, upcoming workshops to be held by the Clackamas County Soil and Water Conservation District was presented.
2. Candidates Brenda Perry and Russell Axelrod spoke about their campaigns for West Linn City Council and answered questions from the members.
