Savannah Oaks Neighborhood Association Meeting September 4, 2012 7:00 PM

Minutes

President Rittenhouse called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. In attendance were 11 members of the Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association.

Old Business:

- 1. Minutes from the August 7th meeting were approved.
- 2. Report on Bland Circle Pump Station: Roberta Schwarz provided an update on the Neighborhood Association's appeal of the Bland Circle Pumping Station.
- 3. Report on White Oak Savanna:
 - a. A total of 1250 hours have been recorded for work on the trail, with a total of 5112 hours spent on the White Oak Savanna Park project in total.
 - b. The dedication of the trail is scheduled for September 29th with representatives from the City of West Linn, the Trust for Public Lands, and Metro scheduled to attend. Albertsons and Neighbors for a Livable West Linn will provide a BBQ lunch and there will be entertainment.
 - c. As for the stairway allegedly encroaching onto Savanna Oaks Park property, first reported to the city in 2010, city officials are saying they looking into the matter.

New Business:

- 1. There was a discussion of the upcoming festival at the Fiala Farm on September 15. The Farm has been a supporter of the WOS.
- 2. At the August 2012 meeting of the Savanna Oaks Neighborhood Association Ed Schwarz was nominated to be the new President (replacing David Rittenhouse who resigned) and Patrick McGuire was nominated to be the new Treasurer. By unanimous votes, both were elected to the positions for which they were nominated.
- 3. David Rittenhouse, the outgoing President/Treasurer, was recognized for his service and hard work during the past several years as head of the neighborhood association.
