III. Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting May 2020 were reviewed and unanimously approved.

IV. Treasurer Report

Bryan Gilbert reported we currently have \$2,206.41 in the bank. Recent credits and debits included:

- Received \$745 from city last summer
- \$14.95 for Zoom call membership

Spending was low since the 4th of July celebration and garage sale were cancelled due to COVID-19. These are typically the biggest expenditures of the year.

VI. New Business

1. Skyline Ridge Pool – Lenette Rucker update

- The pool will be open this summer from May 22 to Sept. 30
- Registration letters will be sent to Skyline Ridge residents next week and will include contact information requests to update the neighborhood directory
- Pool rules will include COVID safety requirements which will follow state and local guidance including temp checks, masks, social distancing
- Swim for Fun has been hired to manage the pool and will have a monitor there during open hours to enforce COVID safety procedures
- Swim lessons will be limited to 8-11:00 AM
- Pricing will be \$600 per family, \$500 for seniors, and \$700 for families outside of Skyline Ridge
