GUEST PRESENTATIONS

1. **Ken Worcester – West Linn Parks & Rec Director:**
 - a. **Water feature** - This will be a nature based concept. Water feature will be located to upper right corner of playground. Several less healthy trees in the new spot will be removed. This will allow fresh water in and also allow for waste water to drain easily. Will include an interactive splash pad and drain into a pollinator garden - hooked up to a pump (children can make dams with material on site- float stuff down). It will look like a stream - no spray heads.

- b. **Bathrooms** – Will remain in their current location with motion security lights / timer.
- c. **Shelter** - will be moved closer to the bathrooms for easy access. Will have two smaller ones.
- d. **Funding** – from GO bond passed in May.
- e. **Tennis** - Upgrade tennis courts and line for pickleball..
- f. **Playground** - The current shelter will be replaced with the new playground. Concept ideas – tree tops – treehouse like – bridges with logs / step-up – climbing wall - zip-line possibly to take advantage of slope. Perhaps neighborhood association can volunteer with playground construction to save money which can then be applied to play activities.
- g. **Sidewalk** - and parking spots installed all along Bittner St
- h. **Fire hall** – lead paint will be removed. Restrooms will be updated, as well as lighting.
- i. **Paths** – ADA compliant throughout the park. Poured concrete.
- j. **Community garden** – east of tennis courts. Water source available close by.
- k. **Next steps:** – need to have a special meeting in Oct to finalize plans. Goal is to get out for bid in the next two months – possibly start construction over the winter and be completed by late spring.

2. **Sunset Neighborhood Picnic** – In view of the redevelopment of the park, the date has been postponed until further confirmation with the parks department. Possibly waiting until sometime in late spring or early summer when the park is finished to have a ‘grand opening’ celebration.
