

Dear Sunset Community,

In adherence to the provisions outlined in the Sunset Neighborhood Association (SNA) Bylaws to uphold accurate membership records, we are putting out an official call for membership declaration. Under Article III, Section 2, C: it is important to note that membership in the SNA is not automatically conferred upon residents; rather, it necessitates an active declaration by each eligible community member. SNA Membership is open to anyone of voting age at a property within Sunset neighborhood boundaries. SNA membership is free and typically involves attendance at quarterly meetings, as well as active engagement and connection within the community.

To formally declare your membership with the Sunset Neighborhood Association(SNA), an opportunity to submit your name to the meeting attendance register and declare your membership will be provided at the upcoming virtual SNA meeting scheduled for **Thursday, May 30th at 7 PM**. For those unable to attend this next meeting, you may submit your written intent to join to SNA's current secretary, Cayetano Gil at <u>sunsetnawestlinn@gmail.com</u>. Declarations of membership will be tallied, and if quorum is satisfied, will be used at the next meeting on May 30th to review and possibly change bylaws. Anyone who believes that they are a current member, *must* also attend the next meeting to declare membership and/or submit their written membership declaration to the secretary to maintain membership.

Key Agenda Items for the upcoming SNA Meeting on May 30th include:

- Formal recording and tally of membership declarations
- If quorum is met, reviewing & voting on proposed amendments to SNA bylaws; including quorum rules
- Open call for nominations for the SNA President role (currently vacant)
