



## 2020/21 Sustainability Advisory Board Website Update Worksheet

This document is a rough draft of ideas for the revision of the SAB portion of the West Linn city website. Subtended bullets *could* be separate pages off the main page headings.

At our November 19 meeting we may want to prioritize our tasks as follows:

1. Agree on the *Sustainability Home* main page headings. See existing <https://westlinnoregon.gov/sustainability>. Probably no more than seven headings.
2. Determine the type of information to be found on these main heading pages.
3. Assign a minimum of one main heading per board member to research and recommend specific information and links to be placed on that page.
4. Agree on a date by which we all share our ideas.
5. Agree on a tentative date (meeting) at which we finalize the new website plan before we send it to city staff for development.

After the SAB has finalized the new website layout it must then be implemented by the city. Once the new website pages have been created, the SAB must be given time to test and evaluate and provide its results to the city. The city will make necessary changes and allow SAB to give final approval before the new web pages go live. The timeline of the website update, testing and final approval will be up to the city based on their staff schedule and workload. It is hoped that the entire project can be completed by summer of 2021.
