

Willamette Falls Neighborhood Association Minutes 8/10/2016

Gail brought the meeting to order at 7:07p.m. We had a quorum of 9 (see sign in sheet).

Elizabeth made the motion to accept the 7/13/2016 minutes with the one stipulated change (Mill Stone statue). Rachel 2nd the motion. Motion passed.

Elizabeth informed us that we have \$5222.78 in our bank account. Kathie got reimbursed \$32.45 for edibles, WL Café got reimbursed \$30.00 for the coffee she brings us every month. She said that we didn't need to, but we want to support our local businesses.

Post Card information. Kathie showed the mock-up that Courtney did. It was submitted to city to get printed.

Fall festival (something we thought of doing to get people involved with WNA). Decided that perhaps that is too soon and that perhaps Feb. (full moon) would be a better choice.

Willamette Falls Heritage Association (under the direction of Jody Carson) is having interpretive panels installed. WNA agreed to spend \$200. for a plaque. (Elizabeth made the motion and Racheal seconded, motion passed). **Revision= the \$200. is to put WNA on the plaque along with other names.**

We had an update from Main Street. There was a grant written for solar lights for the trees, to be installed before Thanksgiving week. Early Oct. class (window display cases for Christmas). Linda does this for a living and will do it for Main Street at no cost. There has been a grant written for bike racks and for outside seating.

Perhaps getting in contact with PGE since WL was the very first electric community. Perhaps they can help with lighting.

There is \$20,000. available annually from the tourism board. (Something to make people linger longer.) **Revision = Main Street received \$20,000., to design seating for the restaurants, Holiday lights. Main Street is applying for \$100,000 for implementation of the design.**

Goals= we need to go over and update the WNA goals (last done in 2003). One goal that needs to be addressed is how to get people to come to Main Street and 10th Street, to keep our businesses going.

Mr. Handris has not found a boutique hotel interested in his property.

The "Storage Unit" proposal is going before the planning commission on Aug. 7th.

August 31st = Allium restaurant is doing a "farm to table" meal in front of the Methodist Church. It will be a 7 course meal for \$75. Of which all of the proceeds go to West Linn Food Pantry.

Elections for officers of WNA will be held in Oct.
