City budget is still in process.

Main Street= Noel and Brad = Farmers Market starts 5/31. 4:00 - 8:00 p.m., rummage sale will be once a month. Street Scape = business grant from City of West Linn. Must be a 5013C, must have ADA, bike tracks, safety. The grant barely covered architects, professional landscaper (Steven Shibley from Estacada). It is a conceptual drawing. Vision Zero = "back in parking". It is to lessen the exposure to traffic. We questioned the pollution of exhaust into restaurant patrons. We felt that the postcard mailing of the questionnaire for said streetscape was not sufficient. Many of us in WNA did not receive it and some of those on Willamette Falls (or a block off) did not receive it. We were told it was due to a lack of funding. Suggestions made were: to put it in the water bill, get nonprofits together to make sure they don't duplicate efforts. There is a need to combine forces and resources.

The suggestion was made that perhaps we need to ask some of our high school students to volunteer to update the city web page, since it is incomplete and difficult to navigate.
