Gail called the meeting to order @ 7:01.

Kathie read the minutes from June 14 meeting. Elizabeth moved to accept the minutes, Julia 2nd, it passed unanimously.

Elizabeth informed us that our account at Pacific West Bank is the same as last month \$3691.32

Gail= we need to check on the placement of WNA wooden signs, and sandwich signs.

Jody Carson and John Klatt = John made a presentation about his application before the city to redo the garage on his property to accommodate his in home photography business (Oregon Historic photos). His next stop is before the Historic review board. The structure is/will be 19' x 18'. He would like to put a studio above the garage. It is a 1940ish garage. It would be climate controlled. The foundation is to be redone (it will look old). He will take the existing garage down and replace it. Garage is not listed as contributing structure. He will save the siding and doors. The slope of the roof will match the slope of the house roof. He will add a shed to the garage (which can be removed if someone wanted to). Studio will be open to the public for shopping (photographs). He will add one more off street parking space. He would like to get this done this year. Colors are to remain the same (butter yellow, green, white trim).

Northwest Self Storage= large equipment to be moved on to property. They are going to open the creek and start work.

Gazebo House on Salamo= they want to annex to the city so they can develop (7 acres). The property (2.5) next to them is considering this also. The consultant would like an R-7 (7,000 sq.ft. lot size). They could then potentially build 50 plus houses. Not in our neighborhood boundary but could drastically effect the F-rated intersection at 10th and Blankenship/Salamo.

Yard signs= Gail political size are \$25.00 each. She will check to see if she could find some less expensive. Sandwich signs= sign printed up, then bolted on to existing sandwich signs.

Main Street= Noelle is going to try to find sponsors to help complete the funding for the next mailing. Every door in WNA ½ page size, full color one side black/white other. We need to see mock-up of said flier.

New meeting place for Historic Main Street meetings is Café West Linn/ Lavender Blue.

Ideas for spending WNA funds= WL Food pantry (perhaps toys at Christmas time) donations in Jan. or Feb., life jackets, free mediator (Clackamas County). Perhaps we could put together a "Brain Storm" board for each meeting for meeting attendees to put their suggestions on.

West Linn Alliance for Inclusiveness = come join them for the parade at 8:30 a.m. please wear white.

Things to do in our community: Clackamas Community College Repertory Theater (comedy of Sherlock Holmes Baskerville).
