Andrew- upcoming bond issue, special election

Renewal of the Bond- no additional taxes. \$18-20 million. If not approved then the money would be gone. Allocation of projects agreed on. Amount of money for each project not decided yet. City has one shot at this. Willamette Falls Neighbors will benefit, projects are: Willamette Falls/River, 10th Street. City must submit finalized wordage for voter pamphlet by tomorrow. Such projects include but, not limited to: parks, library (roof and generator), city hall, Willamette River public access, field renovations, highway 43, safe routes to schools, road construction.

Historic Willamette- St. Patrick's Day, bus leaves @ 6pm check in @ 5pm. Walking tour begins @ 8:30. Farmer Market will start the first Wed. in June. It has a new manager.

Elizabeth made the motion to accept the Jan. minutes (Feb. was cancelled due to weather). Brad seconded, it was unanimous.

Elizabeth informed us that we have \$2591.94 in the bank. She informed us that the money was spent on office supplies and refreshments for meetings.

Land Use – Shari's = the land has been sold and developers would like to put up a dental office/medical building and a fast food with drive in building. Would mean dividing lot. Stairs on this property need to be cleaned up, may have been done today.

Danny Belding – Fred Meyer (Oregon City) = Haggan's space is too small. Nothing can be done until the lease is up.

Robinson Foster = Rail solution ODOT did not look in other transportation modes for traffic, thus against Federal EPA standards. Tolling= ODOT left out non highway solutions. Suggestions to look into, the reopening of the Willamette Falls locks (water ferries and shipping), railway service (land ferries) would reduce congestion, road and bridge wear and destruction. ODOT needs to become Department of Transportation not Department of Highway.
