Haggens Grocery Store = no news. How about putting the Post Office there? They could use all or some of the property.

Bus barn site = \$850,000. Paint project has "gone away".

>Main Street — Rae = Wine Walk on Friday. 17 wineries \$15.00 per person (includes glass). Julia was promoted to chair. There will be an open house on Oct. 25th (or so). Main Street to become self-sustainable with money from memberships. Halloween theme is a sea theme, emblem in windows for businesses with candy. Pumpkin carving contest. Working on grants for "non-motorized boat ramp accessories (Lockers, etc.). Wayfinding app.

>West Linn Historical Society = living history tour. 1922 theme. 5^{th} and 6^{th} Streets to be closed for this. 108 volunteers, 3-4 cars (circa 198 - 1943). No carriages. 170 sold, sold out. City changing historic code.

>West Linn Food Pantry needs an executive director.

> Water Shed Tour = Oct. 6^{th} 8:30 – 3:00.
