

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 by President, Kathie Halicki.
The minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

The Willamette Garage

Presenters Mary Brennock, Kris Tour and John Stromquist described the vision, goals and design for the rehabilitated and restored garage at Dollar and WF Drive.

This endeavor hopes to add jobs, increase foot traffic and generate tax revenue for West Linn. The Garage will accommodate live music, special events, and rental space for private parties.

Eight food carts will be spaced 5' apart with seating under cover of the canopy. Picnic tables, a fire pit, and landscaping are planned for the exterior while a bar will be inside with a 'gas station' decor.

The menus will include Greek, Thai, Indian, German, sushi, and sliders. Late June or early July is the planned opening. Carts will be open 5 days a week and possibly 6. Security cameras will be in place but no fence will surround.

Main Street:

Rebecca gave a rundown of summer events. The Wine Walk will take place in September. The Old Time Fair will be July 14, 15, and 16 and the Street Dance will be August 20th.

The Wednesday Summer Market has drawn large crowds and volunteers are still needed.

She announced the departure of the WL City Manager in August and Tech Support on June 24.

WF Drive Update:

Elizabeth reported that Lance Calvert met with home owners on WF Drive near Fields Bridge Park. He reassured them that no changes will be made on the south side affecting their frontage because of no funding. However street improvements will severely alter the Hoods landscape.

The existing crosswalk will be moved east of the intersection.

June 21 the Council will be reviewing improvements to Fields Bridge Park.
June 16 the planning commission will discuss roundabouts on WF Drive.

Volpp Street:

Greg and Becky Smith have volunteered to be members of a waterfront improvement committee. Currently Volpp Street is being surveyed. The Volpp Street widening project has been decoupled from the park/boat ramp project. Residents will be included in any proposed changes but no time line exists as yet.
