tips: Replace smoke alarms every 5 years
Don't store used batteries...they can explode
Fireplace ashes can take several days to cool
Fire extinguishers are a good investment and easy to use
Don't overload cords at an outlet...fire can start in the wall
Outline an escape plan in case of fire
Organize an emergency kit
Make an explicit list of medications, etc for emergency responders
