

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 by President Kathie Halicki.

**Minutes** of the March meeting were approved as shown on the WL Meetings page.

**The Treasury** has a balance of \$3,211.92.

**The West Linn Historical Society** made a presentation describing its activities which include a quarterly newsletter called 'The Meteor', 5 minute 'Ignite' events, 1956 Radio Show and displays at the Old City Hall. A Vaudeville Variety Show is planned for June 13th followed by tours of the MacLaine House on June 14th.

The West Linn Historical Society has a website, fifty members, a \$25 annual membership and a Board of 7 members. In addition to activities for the public, they have produced two books: West Linn Parks and a 'Then and Now' book of house photos.

**Comments:** The WNA will need to renew its Zoom use in September for \$160.

If we decide to move meetings to the Police Station in September, we will need to put a notice on our meeting signs.

**The Food Pantry:** reported an average of 60 families needing food boxes weekly. Upon occasion the number is up to 74. They always need cash to buy dairy and perishables. The Pantry has applied for a grant from the city which will provide funds for those purchases. They recently received a grant to provide food boxes for children who might not have food on weekends.

**Land use issues:** A long discussion ensued as to the excavation, construction and soils involved with the Tannler Drive development. Potential land slippage, noise, and vibration from excavation are issues that could affect neighbors. Apartment blocks of three and four stories, narrow streets and limited parking are points of interest. A small amount of commercial space is included. New traffic patterns and traffic volumes are additional concerns.

This plan is still in the works. More information is available at the WL Planning office.
